Discuss the school values and what they mean. How can we show them at home?

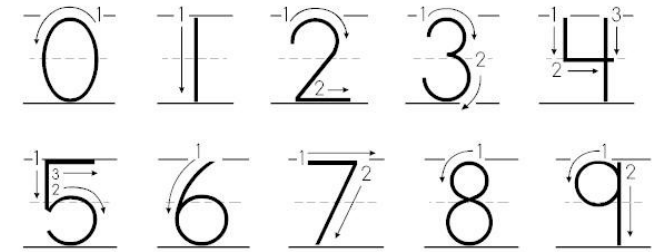

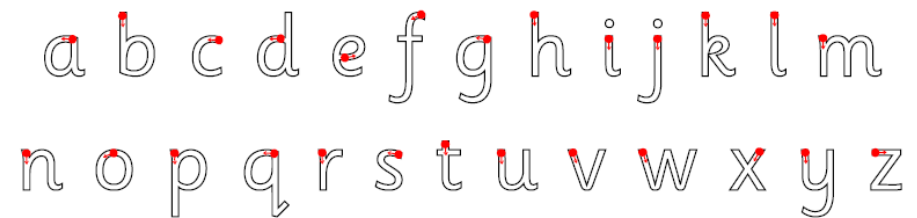
