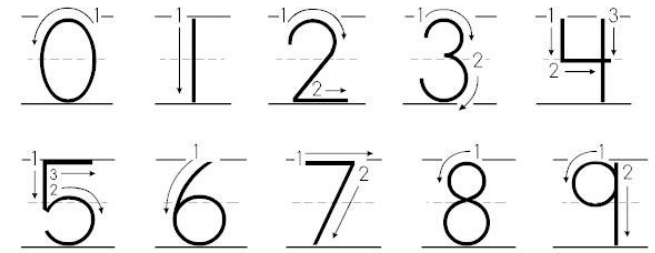

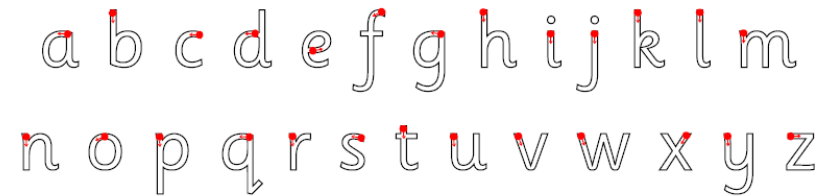

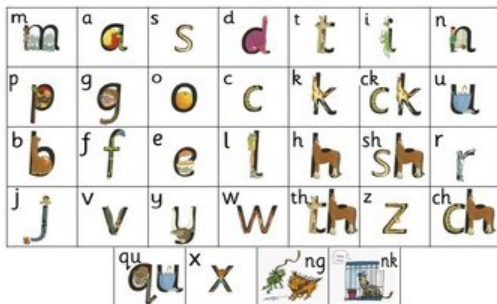
Things to practise at home.
