

STUDENT PLACEMENT POLICY

The provision is aware that a pre-school provision provides an ideal place for students from child care courses, on placement from schools colleges, as well as Wales PPA Courses.

When students are welcomed into the provision:

- the needs of all the children are paramount. Students will not be admitted in numbers which hinder the work of the group
- students must be confirmed by their tutor as being part of a bone fide child care course
- a CRB check will be required for all students with a placement of more than 6 weeks over the age of 16 years
- students need to be given an induction to the provision
- students will not be included in the adult/child ratios
- no student will be left in an unsupervised position with any child
- students will not be included in the adult/child ratios
- students will be expected to have a level of commitment
- students will be expected to wear appropriate clothing
- written permission must be obtained from the child's parents if they are required to carry out a child study
- any information gained by students, about the children, families or other adults in the provision must remain confidential.
- students will be welcomed and supported by the provision, in keeping with the Equal Opportunities Policy
- Students who are completing a Duke Of Edinburgh course, can help out under the supervision of staff at all times.
