Measure



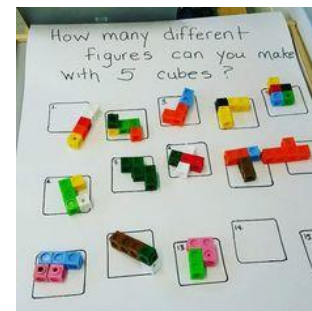
Can you draw Rapunzel then measure her hair using non-standard measures (such as blocks, pencils, flowers, anything really!)

Shape - sculpting



You could have a go at making a bog baby out of clay or playdoh. Talk about the number of eyes, ears, mouth etc. Discuss what shapes are needed to make it.

Number -counting



Concept of number - how many different figures can you make with 5 cubes?

Measure-size



You could have a go at drawing the bog baby, talk about what shapes are needed. You can also discuss the size and position of its features on the body.

Measure and shape

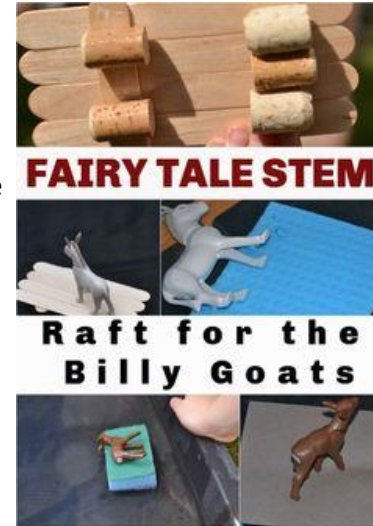
Why not make a crown? Challenge Your child to talk about the shapes they choose and to maybe make a pattern.
