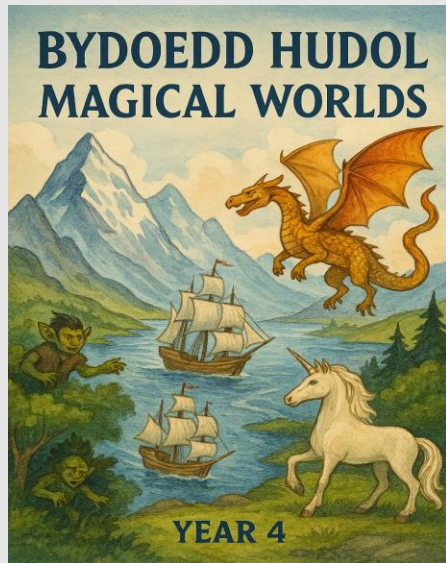


Our school theme this term is People

### Humanities

We will be developing our enquiry skills by considering different sources of information and whether they are reliable evidence. We will also be developing our understanding of Welsh history and folklore.

### Health and Well being

In PE, the children will be having sessions led by a cricket coach to develop their throwing, batting and catching skills.

On a Tuesday afternoon, the children will be exploring Welsh folk dance- Dawnsio Gwerin- in preparation for our school Eisteddfod.

### Literacy, Language and Communication

In Literacy, we will be reading fictional texts relating to our topic. We will also be learning how to write persuasively and debate. As we will be preparing for our Eisteddfod, the children will be learning Welsh poems and songs to perform as part of our school competition.



### Science and Technology

This term we will be designing, making and testing boats that would sail through our magical world. Within this, we will be exploring forces. Our trip this term to Eureka! Science Museum will teach the children all about robotics.



### Expressive Arts

The children will be learning and practising poems to perform in our school Eisteddfod. We will be creating our own mythological creatures and redrafting with feedback from our friends. We will also be exploring clay work.



### Homework

We will continue to set homework each Friday. These will include 'must tasks', which practise skills such as times tables and reading. We will also set 'could tasks', these will usually be based on our topic, or whatever we feel is relevant in our learning that week.
