



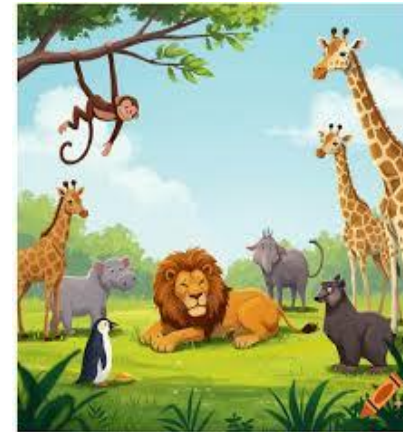
Our topic in Year 1 this term is 'Planhig a Paw' 'Plants and Paws'
